

Students Manual for Online Tests

1. Create an account at GyanKatta.com using a valid email id.

Remember your username and password.
If you forget the password, reset it using email id.

2. Use secret enrolment key provided by your teacher to enrol in your institute section to access the tests. Only enrolled students can see and attempt the tests.
3. Make sure that you have access and can attempt the practice test in your institute section, at least 24 hours prior to the slotted examination time.

Unauthorized absence

If a student is absent from the examination or in the examination centre without permission, or although present at an examination, either does not attempt the paper or attempts so little that it cannot be assessed, and provides no evidence of extenuating circumstances, then the student is awarded a mark of zero for the missed/non-Attempted examination.

It is advised to final submit the examination attempt and wait till the submission confirmation is displayed. An email acknowledging the attempt submission is also sent to students registered email address, immediately.

- All questions are multiple choice questions (MCQs) and students are required to choose the right, or the closest, answer from the choices given.
- The final score, correct / incorrect answers and there explanations will be displayed on the screen immediately after the completion of the test, if permitted by the institute.
